Guidelines

- 1. Artwork must be created by the 4-H member.
- 2. Art is due to the Extension Office by February 29, 2024.
- 3. Artwork should <u>not</u> be framed or mounted. Place artwork in a page protector, if possible.
- 4. Write 4-H member's name, age, school, and grade on the back of the artwork.
- 5. Danish ribbons will be awarded based on the quality of the artwork. One champion will be selected.

Art Category

Drawing in a circle — draw or trace a circle onto an unlined paper; then draw a subject of your choice inside the circle such as scenery, animals, faces, etc.

Tips for circle drawings

- Research "simple drawing in a circle ideas" on Pinterest, YouTube, or other internet sites to see ideas (i.e. Google images).
- Use unlined copier paper or art paper.
- Use a protractor or larger food can to draw your circle.
- Lightly sketch your drawing in pencil to get the correct proportions before making your lines heavier and applying shading/shadows.
- Finish your drawing with black ink.
- Fill up the circle as much as possible with your artwork.
